Minutes of 1st meeting of Project Evaluation Committee in respect of Sidhatha Medium Irrigation Project, Distt. Kangra (HP) held under the Chairmanship of Shri P C Dhiman, Addl.Chief Secretary (IPH) Govt. of H.P. on 04-8-2015 at Shimla

The First meeting of the Project Evaluation Committee (PEC) in respect of Sidhatha Medium Irrigation Project, Distt. Kangra (HP) was held under the Chairmanship of Shri P C Dhiman, Addl.Chief Secretary (IPH) Govt. of H.P. on 04-8-2015 in Annexe Committee Room, H.P. Secretariat, Shimla

The list of participants is attached as Annexure-A.

At the outset of the meeting, ACS (IPH) to the GOHP welcomed all the members/ participants and explained the need for constituting the Project Evaluation Committee and objectives of the meeting. This was followed by quick round of introduction, followed by the presentation made by the Member Secretary cum-SE(IPH) Nurpur, Distt. Kangra on Sidhatha Medium Irrigation Project. The Chairman observed that Photo of Masroor, Guler Paintings and Pong Dam may be attached in the presentation. It was followed by the discussion on various issues pertaining to the Sidhatha MIP.

Following decisions were taken about Sidhatha MIP :-

1. All out efforts shall be made by the IPH department to activate the Water User Associations (WUAs) and it shall also be ensured that at least one meeting is held by each WUA every month and it must be attended by a functionary of the IPH department and proper record of the proceedings is maintained. Issues like regular elections through General House and Warabandi etc must be discussed in the meeting. The IPH department will share the DPR of the CAD of the MIP with all the line departments who are members of the PEC and seek their suggestions for making further improvement and for bringing more areas under crop diversification in the coming months where irrigation facilities have already been provided. The possibility to involve the field staff of line departments with WUAs as official members should also be explored and discussed in the meetings. However, the provisions of Draft Participatory Irrigation Management bill is taken care of while liaise with WUAs. Pattern of warabandi and functions/ role of WUAs be obtained from neighboring States, i.e. Punjab & Haryana.
2. I&PH Department shall ensure assured irrigation so that total CCA of 2250 hect. is achieved. IPH Officers must have meetings with WUAs more frequently and ACS(IPH) would also interact with WUAs/ beneficiaries through VC before next meeting.

3. Co-operation Department would explore the possibility of linking of WUBs with Agriculture Co-op. Societies in the Sidhatha MIP area and the farmers of the area would be approached by the field functionaries of the IPH department and the Co-operation department to make them aware about various incentives under different schemes of the government.
4. The agriculture Department shall identify and provide a list of Area, people/ beneficiaries for diversification of agricultural crops and fodder/ vegetable raising in the Command Area of Sidhatha MIP within 30 days to IPH Department & Registrar Co-operative Societies regarding issue discussed at serial number 2 above. At least three crops in a year should be taken.
5. Animal Husbandry and Fisheries Departments would identify the activities related to their sectors in the Command area of the MIP. Animal husbandry Department would provide demonstrative kit to farmers of COA and directions to DD, AH Kangra would also be issued in this regard. and the IPH department shall ensure that traditional water sources are all recharged for making them suitable for fisheries cultivation.
6. Agriculture/Horticulture Department would organize the trainings to the farmers at project site and, trainings and demonstration plots through JHE Solar either in the University Campus or at local sites shall be organized by the UHF and Agriculture University. More possibilities will be explored for adding cash crops by Horticulture/Agriculture Department and inspire the farmers for off season vegetables.
7. IPH Department shall provide a copy of DPR of CAD of Sidhatha to all stakeholder/line Departments.
8. The IPH department shall immediately make the hydropower station operational by taking all required safety measures and by maintaining safety standards to utilize/ harvest the financial investment made by the department.
9. The IPH Department shall immediately ensure testing of SHEP Anubi free and trial be done in time bound manner.
10. SE, Nurpur shall ensure that meeting of Distt. Irrigation Committee Kangra is convened regularly by D.C. Kangra as is being done in Bilaspur and other districts so that there is better co-ordination amongst all the departments and the farmers of the area are served better.
11. It was further resolved that next meeting shall be convened exactly after two months and all the decisions taken today shall be reviewed at that time.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to all the participants.
