Subject:- Review meeting of drought situation in Himachal Pradesh through Video Conference held on 07.05.2016 under the Chairpersonship of Secretary (IPH) to the Govt. of H.P.

During the video conference, the information supplied by various zones was discussed and it was noticed that during review meetings of different zone held from 20th April to 28th April, 2016, all the zones had confirmed that there is normal situation of water supply in the State. In this video conference as per data supplied by Shimla-9, Una & Bilaspur, the demand of Rs.41.42 crores was put up which indicates that either the data discussed during review meeting was wrong or this information submitted by various zones/circles is contradictory.

During discussion, it was desired by Worthy Secretary (IPH) to the Govt. of H.P. that all the data of schemes where water is being supplied by the department on every 3rd day or more may be monitored regularly. The next video conference on this issue will be held in 2nd week of May, 2016 at any time.

You are, therefore, requested to supply the detail of schemes/habitations where water is being supplied to the public on 3rd day or more as under:-


1) Name of scheme 2) affected habitation/population 3) lean period discharge of source as per approved estimate 4) Lean period discharge of source for last three years 5) Water being supplied in LPS during normal time 6) Water being supplied in LPS presently 7) No. of Hand Pump in affected area/habitation indicating its no., its longitude/latitude 8) Position of Hand Pump indicating functional/non-functional and reason thereof.

The name of Nodal Officer in these schemes at all level indicating name and telephone no. may be indicated. It may also be ensured that no tanker be deployed without prior approval of the concerned Chief Engineer. Also energisation of hand pump be avoided as this is our alternative service to supplement the water supply to public.

If, under any un-avoidable circumstances, energisation is

copy to Secretary(IPH) and this office by justifying its need. Besides, prompt response to Press news where water problem are being highlighted by the Press should be made by the concerned CE/SE.
