**Subject:- Yearly Data Update, 2016-17.**

This is with reference to decision taken in the SLSSC meeting held on dated 26.11.2015, vide which Additional Chief Secretary (ACS) IPH had directed that category wise status of habitations may not be changed in the yearly data updation module without obtaining approval from Government. Accordingly necessary directions were conveyed to all Chief Engineers, Superintending Engineers and Nodal officers vide this office letter No. SE (P&I)-I-Survey Status/2015-4095-4115 dated 2.12.2015.

Joint Secretary (Water) Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation Govt. of India vide D.O. No. F.No.-Q-14021/1/2016-stat dated 31<sup>st</sup> March,2016, uploaded on the IMIS website (copy enclosed), has informed about Yearly Data Updation (YDU) in IMIS for the year 2016-17 shall be opened shortly for State / UTs. The following steps have been prescribed for completion of the tasks:

- a) The habitation directory has to be updated in co-ordination with the SBM co-ordinates and approved by the IMIS nodal officer before the process of updation of data commences. Updation of Panchayat's data as per Directory of the Ministry of Panchayati Raj have to be done on this portal before doing it on IMIS.
- b) Laboratory testing of samples have to be entered in the water sample testing format to validate quality affected habitations in YDU.
- c) Project Shelf of 2015-16 may be finalized before entering shelf of projects to be executed in 2016-17.
- d) As LPCD is calculated from available LPD entered against each source/ delivery point, any left out scheme/delivery point details may be updated before working on the YDU.

It is therefore requested to go through the matter personally **keeping in view the decision taken by SLSSC on dated 26.11.2015** and direct the field functionaries to re-examine the status of water supply schemes on the factual basis. If updation is required, the field status should be verified by at least Executive Engineer of the concerned Division and Circle-wise consolidated case should be sent to this office along with following information:

Consolidated information should be sent to this office within weeks time positively so that necessary approval for updation can be obtained from the Government in time.

It is also intimated that directions already issued regarding completion of ongoing schemes more than 10 years ,5years & 3 years, may also be followed strictly.

Project Shelf of 2015-16 may be finalized before entering shelf of projects to be executed during 2016-17.


It is also intimated that keeping in view the likely allocation of funds under NRDWP for the current financial year 2016-17, tentative target for coverage of habitations has been fixed as 1300 habitations. Zone wise projection of targets is as under:-

As per GoI guide lines, priority for coverage of habitations having category 0%-25% with 40 LPCD should also be followed and all such habitations should be planned to be covered in the current financial year before covering the habitations of 25-50% category. Directions in this regard have earlier been issued vide t/o letter No. IPH-P&I-I-NRDWP/2016-1793-1800 dated 21.03.2016.

It may also be ensured that before marking the habitations for coverage in the project shelf for the year 2016-17, PC habitations falls under SAGY shall also be prioritized positively under target for the current financial year 2016-17. To expedite the process, schemes for SAGY habitations can be sanctioned by the Principal Secretary / Secretary / Competent authority of the state which can later be ratified by State Level Scheme Sanctioning Committee (SLSSC).
