Your attention is drawn towards this office D.O. No.IPH-SP-I-GI Pipes/2016-1802-05 dated 28.03.2016 vide which decision taken in the meeting held under the Chairpersonship of Hon'ble IPH Minister on dated 17.03.2016 conveyed vide Secretary(IPH) to the Govt. of H.P. letter No.IPH-B(F)5-2/2013-Part-I dated 23.03.2016 (copy enclosed).

As observed from the IMIS module the MAS & Stock balances of G.I.Pipes of various divisions available in stocks is to the tune of 21690.66 MT on dated 31.01.2016, which as per average monthly consumption of G.I.Pipes in the state is sufficient to meet the requirement of next 6-7 months. Although strict instruction has already been conveyed to transfer the surplus pipes within divisions, circle, zones as well as inter zone, it appears that this exercise has not been carried out as various public representatives are time and again raising the issue of non-availability of G.I. Pipes in most of the divisions.

It is, therefore, once again emphasized that extensive exercise starting at Sub-division level be made immediately to work out the net requirement of pipes as well as surplus pipes in each Sub-division for necessary action to be taken by the concerned Division/Circle/Zone. Information on the following proforma be prepared and conveyed to this office while carrying out this exercise:-

This proforma shall reach next superior officer by 5th of every month i.e. from AE to EE from EE to SE and from SE to CE. Chief Engineers should send consolidated information with clear requirement of specific dia pipes to this office in forwarding letter.

Based on the information received by every 5th, the superior officer will be responsible for transfer of pipes within his jurisdiction in the next 15 days. While making transfer, the superior officer shall be held responsible if such transfer will create avoidable shortfall in the sub-division/division/circle from where the transfer is effected.

Please ensure that above information may be supplied to this office

strictly as per prescribed schedule.

transfers be made at Engineer-in-Chief level.

With respect to the issue of shortage of pipes being raised by some public representative, the Department may issue orders authorizing and fixing responsibility for short term transfer of pipes within jurisdiction of specific officers so that there is no shortage either in the place where inadequacy is felt for in the place from where pipes are transferred. For example, Executive Engineers should be assigned responsibility to do transfers of pipes within their jurisdiction, Superintending Engineers beyond that (that is within Circles), Chief Engineers within Zones and inter-zone

A performa be devised to check for availability within each unit/division so that no sudden shortfalls occur. The superior officer responsible for making short term transfers should review this every month and be totally clear of the status of pipes in his jurisdiction. Serious note will be taken of complaints of shortages once such instructions are issued. The office demanding pipes must ask for specific diameter pipes atleast one month before he expects an inadequacy to occur to enable the superior office to make proper arrangements.

The orders be issued to all concerned within 2 days, under intimation to this office.
