The District Level Task Force (DLTF) shall keep regular watch over the mining activities and movement of minerals in the District. The DLTF shall have its regular meetings, preferably every month to reconcile the information from the mining activity, and other observations made during the month and take appropriate corrective and remedial action, which may include a recommendation for revoking mining lease or environmental clearance. The DLTF may constitute an independent committee of the experts to assess the environmental or ecological damage caused due to illegal mining and recommend recovery of environmental

compensation from the miner's concern. The recommendation may also include action under the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
